New Tee Time Procedure for Tuesday Play at the Meadows

Why a new procedure?

Golf continues to be one of the most desired activities amongst our membership and the number of registered golfers continues to increase. To alleviate the concerns that surround the number of golfers that congregate weekly at the first tee box at the Meadows Golf Course (The Meadows), which at times can be loud and somewhat chaotic, a new tee time procedure has been adopted and must be adhered to.

Effective with the opening of the 2017 outdoor golf season all Hobbyist registered golfers, who play on a weekly basis at The Meadows, must adhere to the following **Assigned Tee Time** policy:

The Meadows continues to provide our club with a block of tee times between 7:00 AM and 8:00 AM except for the month of April which is 8:00 AM through 9:00AM. Each month, a weekly schedule is produced placing golfers in foursomes, and threesomes on a weekly basis. Each group is assigned a captain and a number i.e. Team 1, Team 2 and so forth until all golfers are placed.

The Change - The role of the captain has not changed. However, the Team number assigned to each group will determine tee times. Team 1 will tee off at 7:00 AM or 8:00 AM in April; Team 2 at 7:10 AM; Team 3 at 7:20; Team 4 at 7:30, and so forth until all team have been assigned a tee time. If your foursome or threesome is not complete and prepared to tee off when it is their time or if your group decides not to play at the Meadows (see below), the group which is scheduled to tee off behind them will move up only if they are prepared to do so. Once the bypassed group is then prepared to tee off, they will be permitted to tee off behind the group on the tee box.

Note: All registered golfers are not required to play weekly at the Meadows Golf Course. The captain of your team will determine the course to be played on. If your team decides not to play during a specific week at the Meadows and your team for example is Team 3 scheduled to tee off at 7:20 AM, Team 4 may tee off at 7:20 if all of their members are prepared to do so.
